

Suggestions for those taking dahlia portraits: Your subject is a single dahlia bloom. Crop if needed to make a wellbalanced image. Make sure your image is of the entire bloom. Do not cut petals off in the image.

Watch your backgrounds for distracting components that do not enhance the photo. If you have an image that is not great as a portrait, consider cropping it into a macro image.


